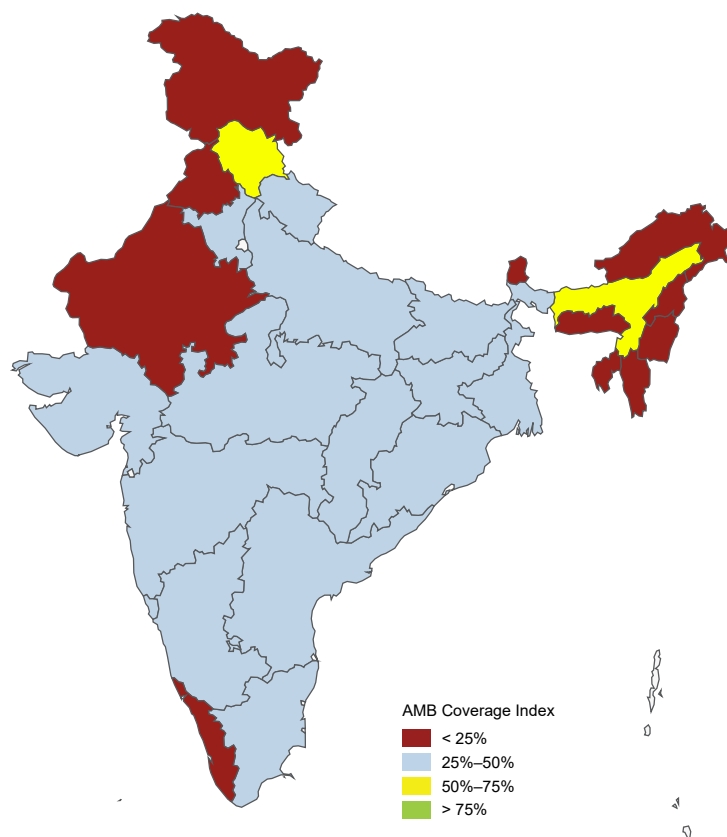
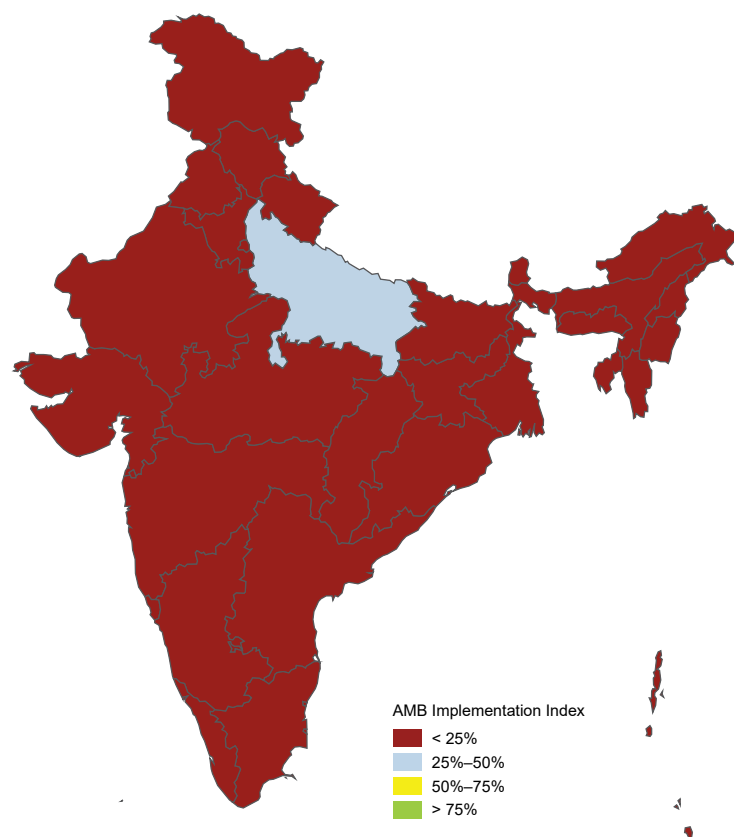

ACHIEVEMENTS

- State nodal officer appointed in 10 states.
- State dissemination workshops conducted in 6 states.
- System Instituted for streamlining AMB monthly HMIS reporting in 6 states.
- AMB as a part of EDL in 13 states.

ACTION POINTS

- AMB program yet to be launched in several States.
- In most of the states, district nodal officers are not appointed in their respective districts under AMB program.
- Institutional partnership mechanism needs to be adopted by most of the States to support AMB capacity building approach.
- District level review of KPI is not yet started in many of the States.
- Effective Communication practices has not yet been developed among the health facilities, ANM and ASHA.
- None of the States have yet started the district outdoor media plan. The plan is yet to come into force.
