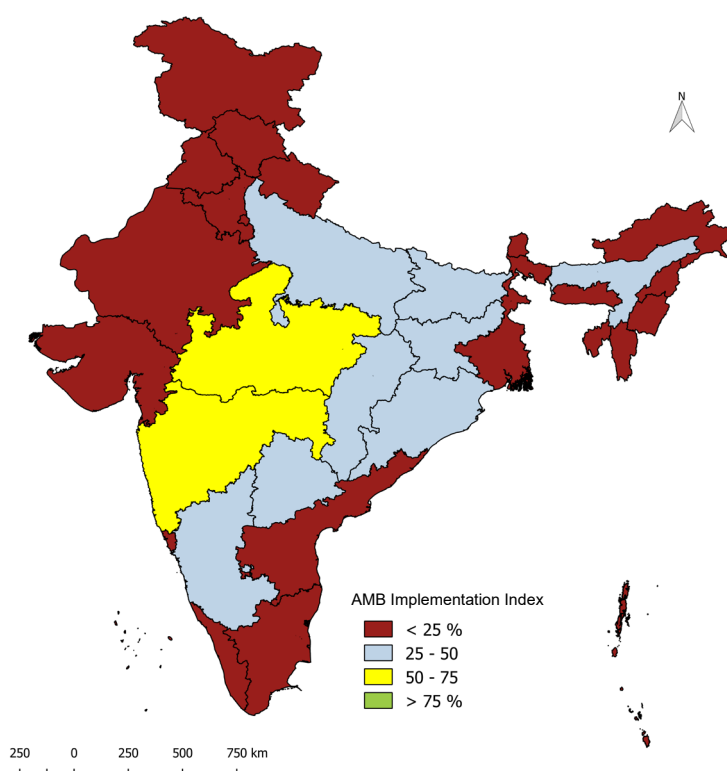
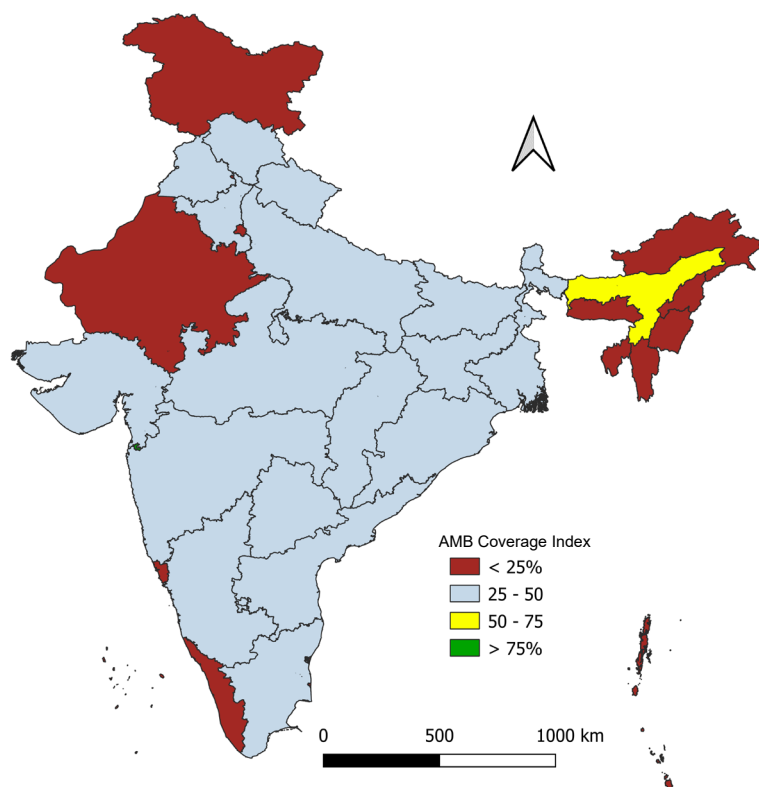

ACHIEVEMENTS

- State dissemination workshops conducted in 12 states.
- In most of the states, state as well as district nodal officers have been appointed in the respective state and district under AMB program.
- AMB supplies, being part of EDL have been drawn under the ambit of review in most of the states.
- Most of the States included AMB as an agenda of the State level review meeting to boost up the average monthly AMB reporting in HMIS portal by the district.
- Most of the states have designed training plan and conducted training programme for the nodal officers of the state and district as well.
- Most of the states have designed AMB communication platform where information could be accessed in regional language of the respective states.

ACTION POINTS

- AMB program yet to be launched in several States.
- Institutional partnership mechanism needs to be adopted by most of the States to support AMB capacity building approach.
- District level review of KPI is not yet started in many of the States like Uttar Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh and West Bengal.
- Effective Communication practices has not yet been developed among the health facilities, ANM and ASHA.
- None of the States have yet started the district outdoor media plan. The plan is yet to come into force.
- State AMB PMU has been established in only five States.
- None of the states have started yet to conduct the operational research utilizing the budget approved by GOI or development partners to the respective states.
