i) AMB Index: The Index is calculated as the simple mean of the four selected coverage key performance indicators.

ii) Numerators are from HMIS Standard Report 2021-22 (up to March 2022). The Denominators are from Anemia Mukht Bharat – Dashboard FY 2021-22 for up to March 2022. The numerators and denominators account for monthly consumption frequency for indicators related to children: 6-59 months, 5-9 years and 10-19 years; and lactating mothers. For HMIS 1.2.4 (Pregnant Women), the denominator is taken from HMIS 1.1 (total number of pregnant women registered for ANC) for the respective month.

iii) States/UT's are ranked based on AMB index with State/UT having highest index value ranked first and so on.

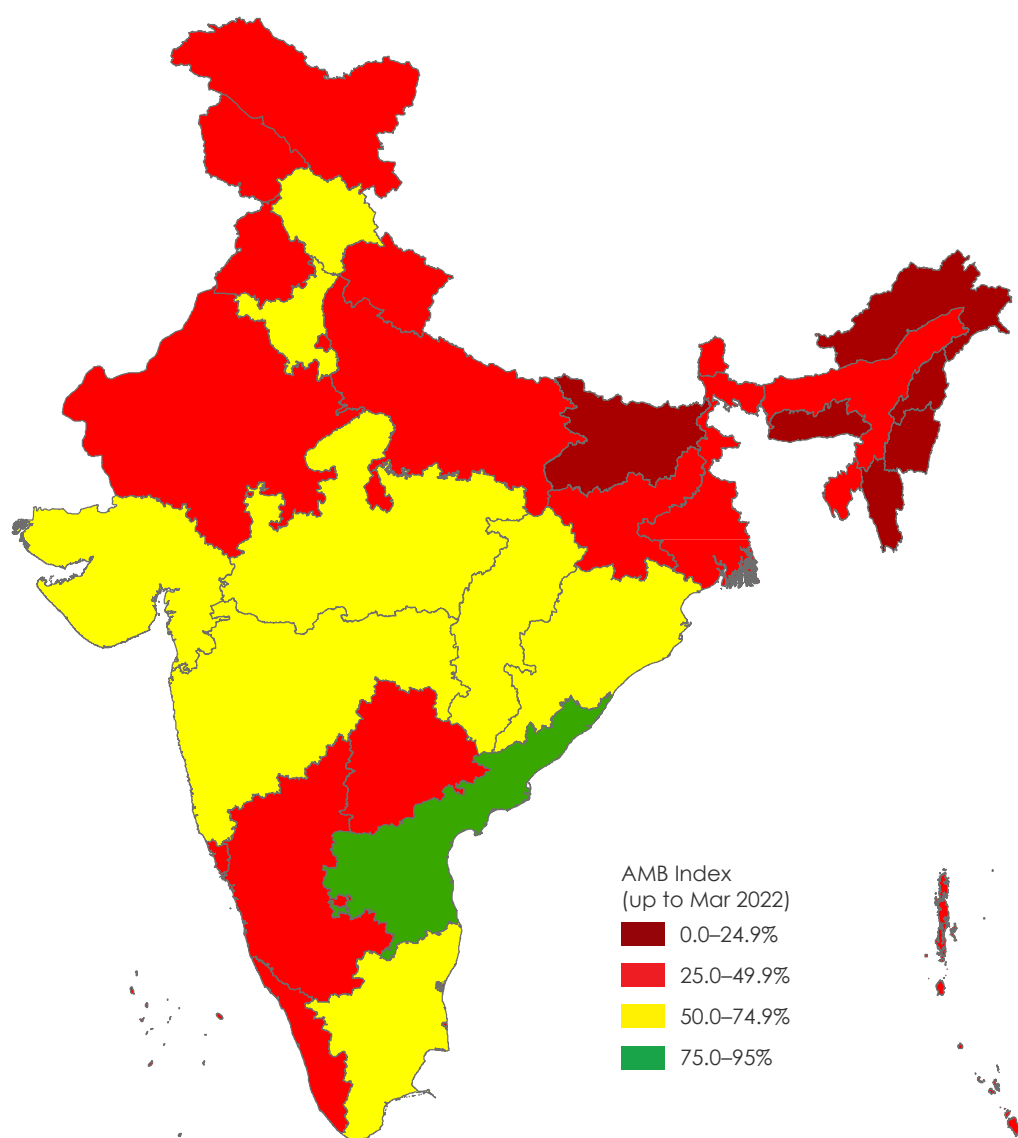
iv) Status as on April 15th, 2022.

* 95% is considered as the ceiling value for HMIS coverage for States/UTs.

The HMIS data item code as per standard report is as follows:

1. HMIS 9.9: Children (6-59 months) provided 8-10 doses (1ml) of IFA syrup (Bi weekly)
2. HMIS 23.1 + 23.3: Children covered under WIFS Junior (5-9 years) provided 4-5 IFA tablets (in schools + out of school) per month
3. HMIS 22.1.1 + 22.1.3: Adolescent (10-19 years) provided 4 IFA tablets (in schools + out of school) per month
4. HMIS 1.2.4: Pregnant women (PW) given 180 IFA tablets
5. HMIS 6.3: Percentage of lactating mothers provided full course of 180 IFA tablets after delivery.

About AMB Score Card

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India has launched the Anemia Mukt Bharat Program for accelerating decline in anemia prevalence and to achieve the POSHAN Abhiyaan (2018-20) target of reducing prevalence of anemia among children 6-59 months, adolescents and women of reproductive age 15–49 years by 3 percentage points per year. The AMB aims to provide preventive and curative mechanisms through a 6×6×6 strategy including six target beneficiaries, six interventions and six institutional mechanisms, for all stakeholders to implement the strategy.

The AMB Score Card is developed with an objective to provide information on coverage of IFA supplementation across selected target beneficiaries to support assessment of progress and performance of the program. The AMB Score Card is based on data from Health Management Information System (HMIS) and AMB Dashboard. The rankings are calculated as the mean coverage of IFA supplementation across selected target beneficiaries. State/UT are ranked in descending order of the mean coverage whereby State/UT with best performance is ranked first.

This scorecard is prepared by Institute of Economic Growth (IEG), Delhi in collaboration with UNICEF.
